- Course to be built by Addington BSJA course designer.
Courses will be up to height

CLASSES

- All classes will be run as a BSJA Single Phase Competition (course in two parts with second part timed. Competitor to jump both parts unless eliminated. Three refusals, instead of two refusals will result in elimination). Faults to be accumulated.

Class 1. Fences approximately 75 - 80 cm. Riders under 13 years of age as of 1/1/2012

Class 2. Fences approximately 80 cm – 85 cm

Class 3. Fences approximately 90 cm

Class 4. Fences approximately 1.00 m

Class 5. Fences approximately 1.05 m

Class 6. Grand Prix – Fences approximately 1.10 to 1.15 m

- **Entry Fee:** £17 per horse per class.

Prizes: Individual rosettes 1st – 10th place in each class

Times: Running order will be available on website <http://branches.pcuk.org/heythrop/> on or before February 10th. It is your responsibility to ensure that you report in good time. Course walk at beginning of each class.

RUN UNDER PONY CLUB and FOLLOWING RULES

1. All competitors must be paid-up members of Pony Club
2. Riders may not compete more than twice in the same class.
3. Horses may only compete once in each class.
4. Horses may compete in a maximum of two classes.
5. The ruling of the judge is final. Objections must be made within 5 minutes of the end of the class in writing with a £30 deposit. Video/photographic evidence is not admissible.
6. In all cases, the term "horse" is used to imply horse or pony. This competition is open to horses of all sizes but they must not be under 4 years of age. No horses may be led.
7. All competitors must be suitably dressed in correct riding attire and hats approved to PAS 015:1998, EN1384:1996, BSEN 1384:1997 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2001 with official Snell label and number, AS/NZS 3838:1998 or the AS/NZS 3838:2003 standards shall be worn correctly fastened at all times when mounted. It is strongly recommended that body protectors are worn when jumping.
8. All entries to be made on official entry form. Entries will be limited and will close on 4th February 2012 or when classes full. **First come, first served basis**. No late entries – substitutions may be accepted at Organiser's discretion.
9. No dogs permitted beyond lorry park.
10. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges, Officials, or Pony Club in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. Everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of all officials, stewards and organisers.
11. The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event in which case the entry fees will be refunded less an administrative fee upon receipt of a request and a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
12. Management and organizers reserve the right to refuse service to anyone who is not friendly. Poorly mannered horses, children, or adults may be asked to leave without prior notice.
