The Unaffiliated Event Days allow riders to take their horses through all three phases of an event competition on all-weather surfaces.

The competition consists of a dressage test, a separate cross-country section (approx 12 – 14 working hunter fences with faultable top elements) in the Outdoor International Arena and a show-jumping round in the Indoor International Arena.

- Riders will only be given a time for the Dressage Phase.
- They must then complete the cross-country phase within 20 minutes of the end of their dressage test.
- Finally they complete the show-jumping phase within 15 minutes of finishing the cross-country phase.

## COMPETITION RULES

1. Open to all competitors
2. Dressage Scoring – The total marks awarded are subtracted from the maximum score and halved to convert the score into penalties.
3. Show Jumping & Cross Country scoring –

Knockdown	4 penalties
1 <sup>st</sup> disobedience	4 penalties
2 <sup>nd</sup> disobedience	8 penalties
3 <sup>rd</sup> disobedience	Elimination
Fall of Horse and or rider	Elimination
Error of Course	Elimination
Omission of obstacle	Elimination
Re-taking an obstacle	Elimination

3b. If you are eliminated during the cross country phase you may continue and jump the showjumping phase.

4. Time allowed calculated at: 350mpm  
In the X- Country & Show Jumping rounds – for every commenced second in excess of the time allowed – 1 penalty. Exceeding the time limit (twice time allowed) incurs elimination. The cross country will consist of approx 12 obstacles of a working hunter nature. They will all have a faultable element to them.

### 5. Dress

Usual dress for Dressage and Show-Jumping. In the cross country section 'colours' may be worn and may also be used for the show-jumping round.

It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet manufactured to BS EN 1384 – ASTM F 1163 – PAS 015 with Kite or higher level of protection. Such headgear must be worn with the chin strap correctly and securely fastened at all times when mounted. Body protectors are not compulsory but are **strongly recommended**

### General Rules

1. Entries are accepted in order of receipt and when classes are full a waiting list will be kept. Only if a S.A.E. is sent with the entry will competitors be notified that they are on the waiting list.
2. Withdrawals & Refunds – Once an entry has been received it is assumed that riders intend to take part. Riders withdrawing before the close of entries who produce a doctor or vet's certificate will have 50% of their entry fee refunded or transferred to a later entry if there is space.
3. **NO REFUND** will be made to those who withdraw after the close of entries.
4. All classes are unaffiliated but are run in accordance with British Eventing Rules where applicable.
5. Horse may compete in NO MORE than two classes per day.
6. The organisers decision is final.
7. The organiser reserves the right to alter or cancel any class they see fit without giving a reason.
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving a reason.
9. Classes may be split if entries warrant.
10. The organisers and landowners will not be held responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, spectators, grooms or any person or property whatsoever. It is a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organiser against any legal action arising from any incident.
11. DOGS: Due to Health & Safety regulations Dogs are not allowed out of the lorry or car parks. DOGS are **NOT ALLOWED** in the cafeteria, grandstands or competition areas.
12. Entry will mean agreement to these rules.
